Therefore, our goal is to provide all students a drug free environment in order to provide a categorical intellectual growth. Each student also holds an individual responsibility to respect the school's policy and abide by it.

The possession, distribution and/or consumption of alcohol, alcoholic beverages, and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited by AIHT. Any student violating these policies will be subject to consequences including termination or suspension. Students at AIHT are also subject to federal, state, and local laws for the possession and distribution of illegal drugs.
